




"I'd like to fly somewhere in a hot-air balloon," said Bert. "I'd like to sail in a beautiful boat on the sea," said Beth.

The Owl and the Pussycat


The Owl and the Pussycat went to sea In a beautiful pea-green boat. They took some honey, and plenty of money Wrapped up in a five-pound note.



What's This?




A dragon? A plant? No! It's a type of sea horse called a leafy sea dragon. When it swims through seaweed, it's hard to spot!
