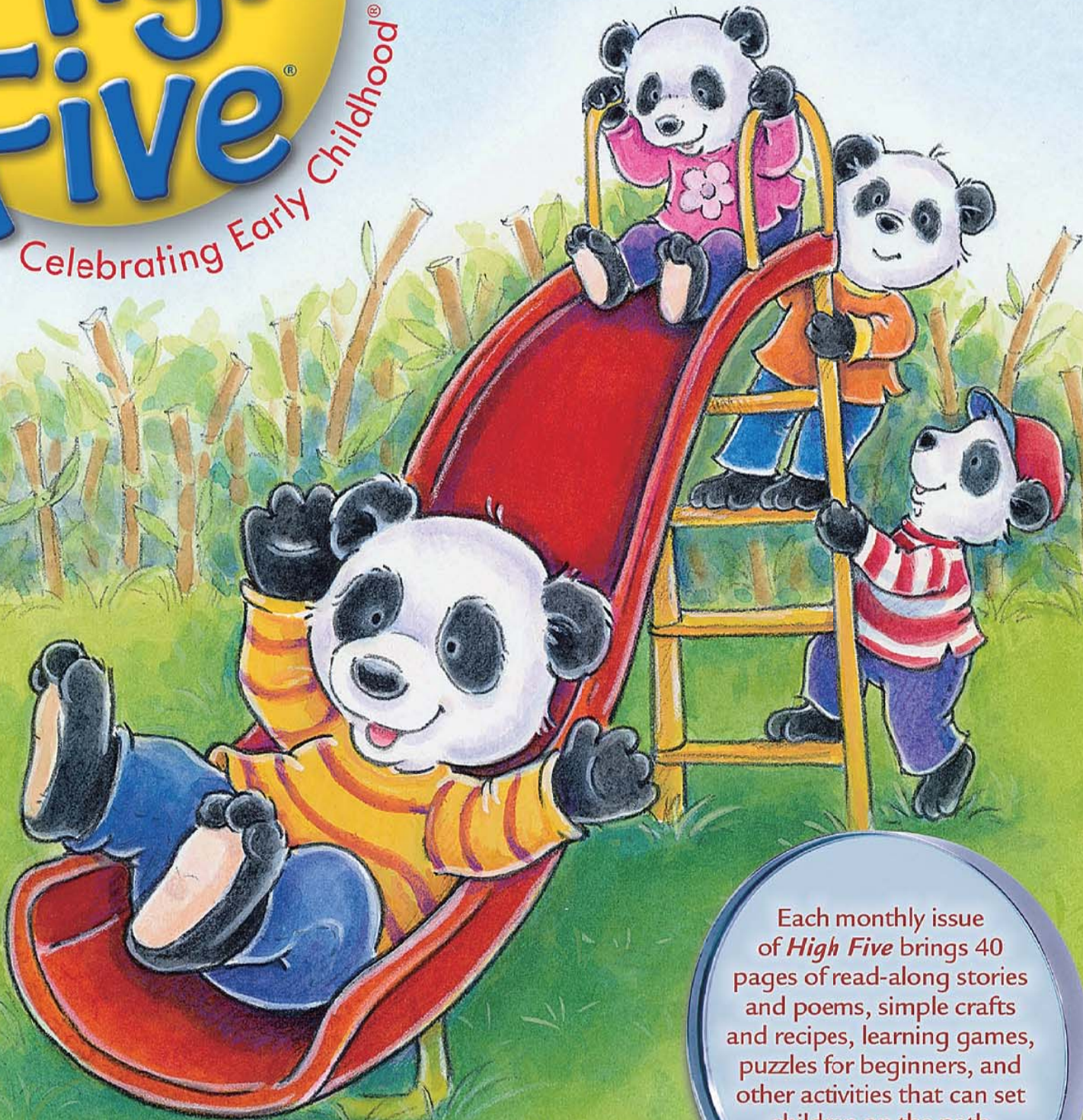

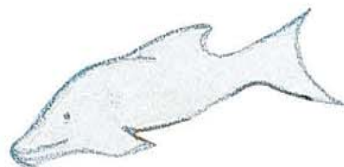

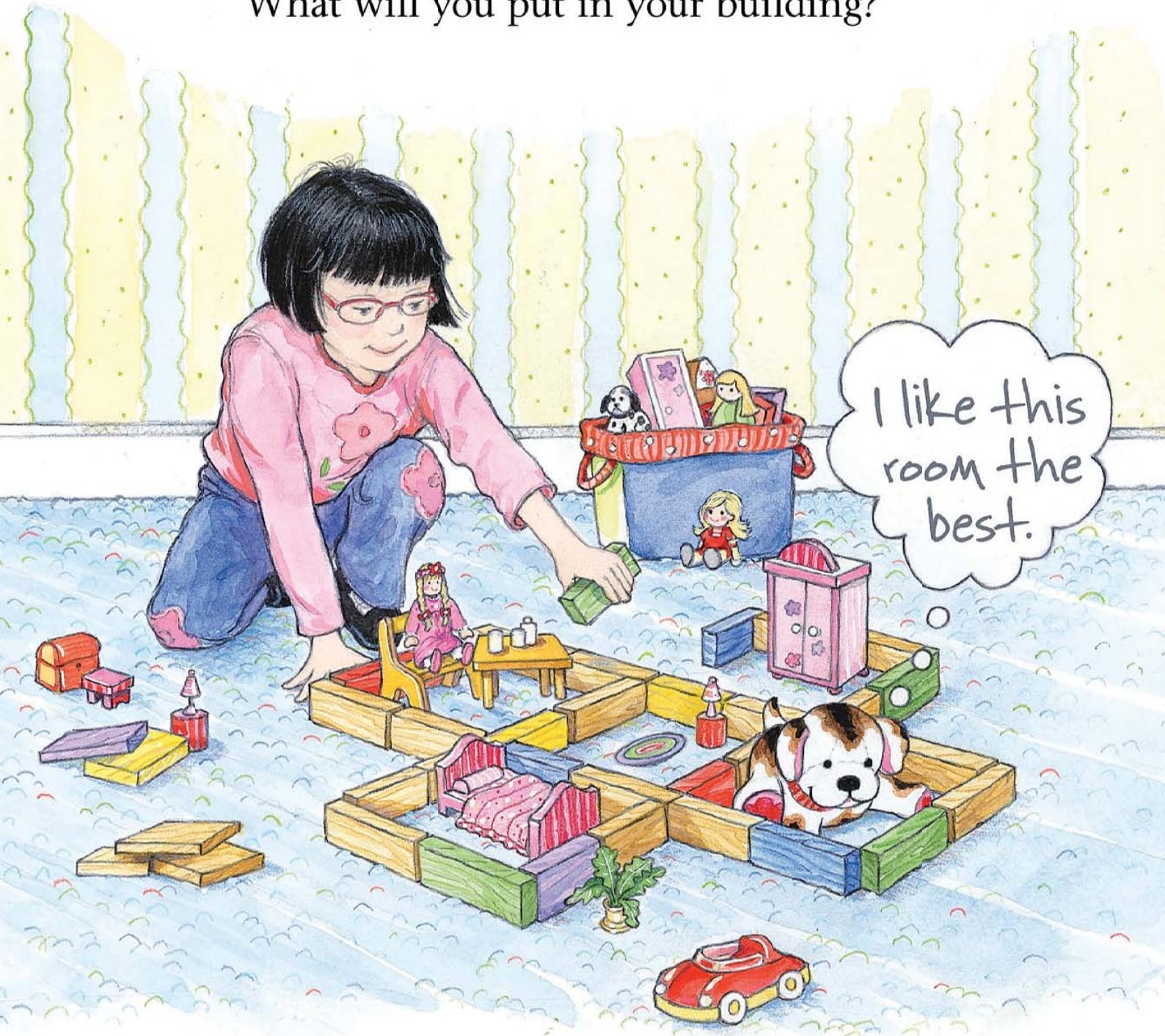

What's This?

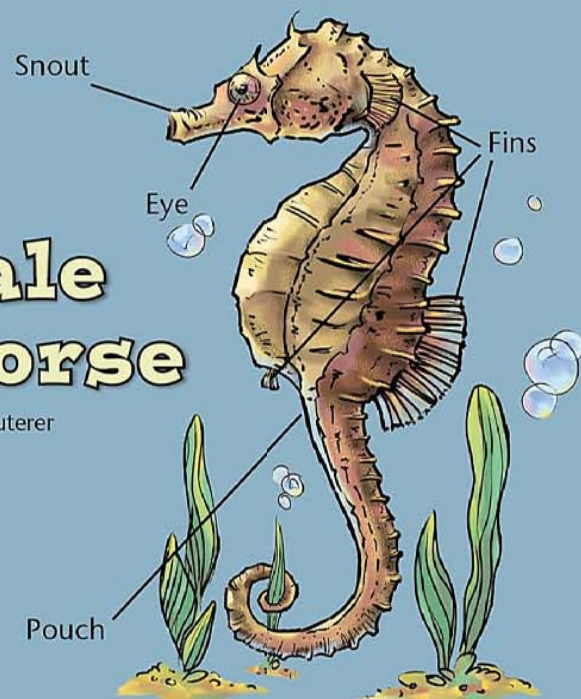


A dragon? A plant? No! It's a type of sea horse called a leafy sea dragon. When it swims through seaweed, it's hard to spot!

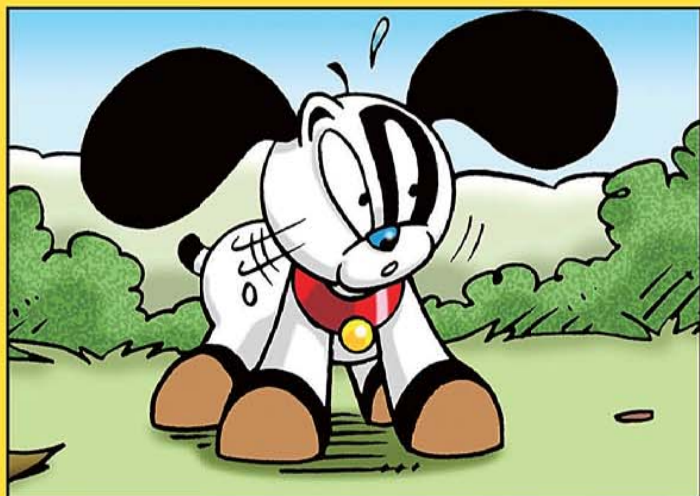

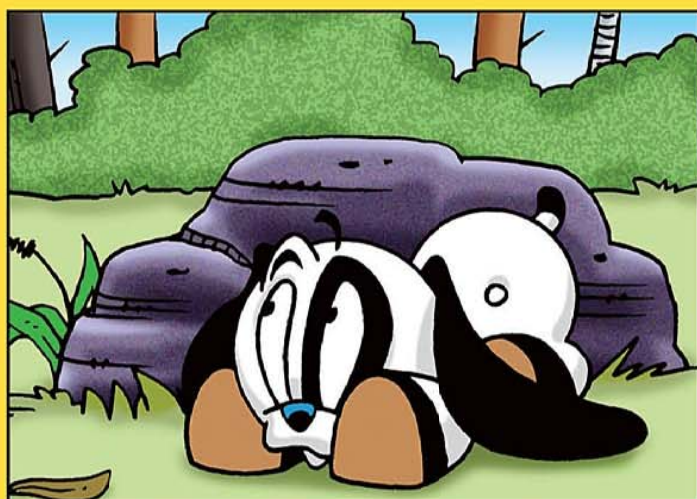
